

10 Day LIGHT Fast

One of the definitions for light in the online dictionary is "something that makes things visible or affords illumination". We need light to illuminate on things we do not see clearly and we need light to invade - spread over darkness. For darkness can only be eliminated by light.

So, during this fast we are going to declare: "Let there be Light" (visibility or illumination) in two areas: 1.) over our youth and 2.) in a situation where darkness seems to be ruling.

Guidelines for fast

- Fast something that means something for you.
 - Find time where you can "still" yourself from the day's activities or distractions in order to meditate. "Be still and know that I am God" (Psalm 46). Meditation quiets our emotions, realigns our mind, and frees our spirit to do the will of God. What we could not hear clearly, we begin to hear.

December 9, 2013

Read: 2 Corinthians 4.

Write down in areas in your own life or your family where there needs to be light. Declare the Prayer for Revelation below.

December 10, 2013

Read: Luke 1:76-80

Prophecy over our youth by declaring: The God-given destiny over our youth will be manifested and fulfilled in Jesus Name.

December 11, 2013

Read: Ecclesiastes 12:1-7, 13, 14

Declare: Our young people will remember and honor the Creator God in the days of their youth.

December 12, 2013

Read Job 1:1-5

We want to follow the example of a man in the Bible named Job, who regularly interceded and sacrificed to God on behalf of his children.

Declare the youth confession below over our youth at church and in your family.

December 13, 2013

Read 1 Samuel 3:1-10

Declare that our youth will hear and listen to God's voice and become agents of change in today's society.

Corporate Prayer Gathering – 9:00am

December 15, 2013

Worship Service – 11:00am

December 16, 2013

Read: Luke 1:26-38

Declare that the power of the Holy Ghost will come upon our young people so they can carry out their destiny.

December 17, 2013

Read: Daniel 1

Declare that our youth will stand courageously for God even when it is not popular.

December 18, 2013

Read: Esther 4 & 5:1-3

Declare that our youth will recognize that they have been called into the kingdom of God for such a time as this and that they will walk in the favor of the Lord.

PRAYER FOR REVELATION

Father, You are a God that reveals secrets. Lord, reveal Your secrets unto us. (Dan. 2:28). Give us the spirit of wisdom and revelation, and let the eyes of our understanding be enlightened.(Eph. 1:17)

Reveal visions and revelations of You. (2 Cor. 12:1)

Reveal to us by the Holy Spirit, the thoughts that are in Your mind. (1 Cor. 2:11)

Reveal Your Word to us. (1 Samuel 3:7)
Reveal to us by the Holy Spirit, what eyes have not seen, ears have not heard, or mind have not conceived. (1 Cor. 2:9).

Reveal to us by the Holy Spirit, all the things that You have prepared for us who love You.(1 Cor. 2:9).

Reveal to us by Your Holy Spirit, all the things You have freely given us.(1 Cor. 2:12).

Reveal to us the secret and deep things(Dan.2:22)

Reveal to us Your thoughts and plans for our lives (Jeremiah 29:11)

Reveal Your glory in our lives. (Isaiah 56:1)

Reveal to us by Your Holy Spirit, all the things that pertain to life and godliness. (2 Pet.1, 3,)

Lord we thank you that light will shine in our hearts. In Jesus Name – AMEN.

YOUTH CONFESSION

I thank You that our youth will know You as Saviour and King and that they will not have to fear or be discouraged for You are with them. (Deuteronomy 31:8).

Lord, I break every negative or derogatory word spoken over our youth in the name of Jesus. I now speak life and peace over our youth in the name of Jesus.

I thank you that our youth are the head and not the tail; above and not beneath. I declare that our youth shall be victorious and prosperous. I declare that they can do all things through Christ who strengthens them.

I break and bind every form of disease and infirmity that will want to attack our youth in the name of Jesus.

I declare that our youth will grow in the fear of the Lord for it is the beginning of wisdom and will bring them peace, prosperity and freedom, in Jesus name. Amen.
